> SOUTH EAST ASIA HIGHLIGHTS GROUP TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1: Bangkok

Welcome to Bangkok! Touch down in Thailand's vibrant capital and meet your Ultimate group and local Adventure Leader. Tonight, get your first taste of the city with a rooftop dinner and a tuk-tuk night tour past Bangkok's illuminated temples and buzzing streets. Finish up with a drink at one of the city's sky-high bars.

Day 2: Bangkok to Chiang Mai

Start your day slow or join an optional tour of Bangkok's Old City, visiting Wat Pho, Wat Arun, and the Grand Palace. This afternoon, you'll store your bags and head to the station to board an overnight train north to Chiang Mai.

Day 3: Chiang Mai

Arrive in Chiang Mai and transfer to your local homestay. After dropping your bags, head straight into the jungle for a 4–6km trek, complete with a stop at a stunning waterfall. Return to your homestay for a home-cooked dinner and a relaxing evening.

Day 4: Chiang Mai

Today we visit an ethical elephant sanctuary for a half-day experience learning about conservation, behaviour, and how to make their favourite snacks. Enjoy a veggie buffet lunch on site. Back in the city, spend the evening at a Muay Thai fight or Thai cooking class – the choice is yours!

Day 5: Chiang Mai

Start your morning with a monk chat and temple visits by songthaew, including the iconic Doi Suthep. This afternoon, you can opt to visit the unique Sticky Waterfall. Tonight, those keen for nightlife can head to the famous Zoe in Yellow.

Day 6: Chiang Mai

Today is a free day to explore Chiang Mai your way. Go whitewater rafting, trek through the mountains, or hit the old town markets for street eats and souvenirs.



Day 7: Chiang Mai to Luang Prabang

Enjoy a chilled morning before flying to Luang Prabang, Laos. Settle into your new hostel and join an optional group dinner, then explore the vibrant Hmong Night Market.

Day 8: Luang Prabang

Start your day with options like the Takbat monk ceremony, a Laotian cooking class, or a cycling/pottery village adventure. In the afternoon, we'll all head to the incredible Kuang Si Falls. Tonight, opt for a traditional Baci ceremony and dinner with a local family.

Day 9: Luang Prabang

Visit the whisky-making village of Ban Xanghai, then cruise the Mekong River to explore the Pak Ou Caves. Stop at Mount Phousi for a sunset view before heading back into town.

Day 10: Luang Prabang to Vang Vieng

Time to hit the road—next stop: Vang Vieng! But first, we're making a cheeky detour to the dreamy Blue Lagoon. Think crystal-clear water, epic scenery, and the perfect excuse to cool off with a swim.

Later, you'll check into your new hostel, get settled, and then the night's yours! Chill out and recharge, or dive into Vang Vieng's buzzing nightlife—it's totally up to you.

Day 11: Vang Vieng Adventure day!

Today's lineup is packed with adventures! You can scale rock faces like a pro, hop on a bike to uncover the coolest spots, and then climb up to Pha Ngern Viewpoint for some seriously epic scenery. If you're feeling more laid-back, grab a rubber tube and drift down the Mekong River while soaking in the stunning views. And when evening hits, it's time to dive into Vang Vieng's vibrant nightlife—endless fun awaits!

Day 12: Vang Vieng to Hanoi

Rise and shine—it's travel day! Kick things off with a bus to the airport and hop on a flight to the buzzing city of Hanoi.

Once you land, you'll cruise into town and settle into your new hostel. As night falls, it's time to hit the streets—go on a street food mission for some mouth-watering local eats, or join the optional bar crawl and dive into Hanoi's nightlife with your new travel crew



Day 13: Hanoi

Today's all about soaking up the culture and history of Hanoi. First stop: Hoa Lo Prison—get ready for a deep dive into Vietnam's past with stories that'll stick with you.

Next up, take a stroll around the iconic Hoan Kiem Lake and check out the temple in the centre. The vibe's super chill, with locals playing games and hanging out along the French-designed streets of the Old Quarter. Feeling peckish? The nearby street food scene has you covered—so many tasty bites to try!

The afternoon's yours to wander Hanoi's maze of narrow alleyways, snap some cool pics, and master the art of dodging scooters like a local pro. And if you're up for something different tonight, why not catch a traditional Water Puppet Show? It's quirky, fun, and totally one-of-a-kind

Day 14: Hanoi to Ha Long Bay

Today's adventure takes you to the magical Halong Bay—think emerald waters, limestone cliffs, and vibes for days.

After arriving at the shores of Lan Ha, you'll hop on a chilled-out cruise and set sail through this absolute dream of a destination. We'll hit up some top spots along the way, where you can dive in for a swim or show off your best boat jump for the 'gram.

As the sun starts to dip, kick back with your crew and enjoy a mouth-watering buffet dinner on board. Good food, great views, and even better company—what more could you ask for?

Day 15: Ha Long Bay to Phong Nha

Start your day with a splash as you grab a kayak and glide across the stunning emerald waters of Halong Bay. With towering limestone cliffs all around, it's basically nature showing off—and you've got front row seats.

Day 17: Phong Nha

Day 18: Hoi An

Day 28: Siem Reap

Day 29: Siem Reap

Today kicks off with a bucket-list moment: watching the sunrise over the mighty Angkor Wat, the world's largest religious monument and an absolute stunner. You'll spend the morning temple-hopping through the ancient ruins, including the jungle-wrapped Ta Prohm—aka the famous Lara Croft: Tomb Raider set.



In the afternoon, hop in a tuk-tuk for the optional Apopo Hero Rats Tour. Yep, real-life rats are helping clear landmines in Cambodia—and you'll see firsthand how these tiny heroes are saving lives every day.

As night falls, keep the good vibes rolling with a ride on a pedal-pub car (yes, it's as fun as it sounds!). Sip on a drink while cruising through the streets, then dive into a feast of Cambodian eats to wrap up the day in true style

Day 30: Siem Reap

Get ready to pedal into your final full day with a half-day cycling tour through Cambodia's gorgeous countryside. You'll cruise past lotus fields, roll through peaceful villages, and stop along the way to check out a duck farm, learn how rice is grown, and even taste some local palm wine—it's the real deal when it comes to authentic village life.

In the afternoon, why not go out with a splash? Head to Cambodia Wake Park for an optional afternoon of watersports fun. Think inflatable obstacle courses, wakeboarding, and even a chill inland beach to kick back on.
